Fifth Meeting, Sub-Working Group on Refugee Women's Health, Migrant and Refugee Women's Health Partnership

18 June 2018

The Sub-Working Group on Refugee Women's Health, Migrant and Refugee Women's Health Partnership held its fifth meeting in Melbourne on 18 June 2018.

The meeting was in conjunction with a roundtable, held in partnership with Harmony Alliance: Migrant and Refugee Women for Change, which focused on enhancing health literacy strategies in the settlement of migrant and refugee women.

The meeting provided an opportunity for the Sub-Working Group to reflect on the matters raised in the roundtable discussions and to identify areas of focus going forward.

The members were updated on the progress of the specific projects under the Partnership's workplan, including:

- Draft competency standards framework for clinicians—*Culturally responsive clinical practice: Working with people from migrant and refugee backgrounds*
- The development of a user guide for health service organisations
- The development of communication to support the work of the Partnership.

The Sub-Working Group will hold its next meeting in September 2018.

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
